Detour and resident access notes:

- All local residents will have access to and from their residence throughout the event, however we request your cooperation in using designated routes.
- Between 8:30am and 11:15am (while Selby Street is closed), the detour route to travel north of Hay St is via Thomas St, Mounts Bay Rd and the Freeway**
- Residents off Cardigan Street can enter and exit via the laneway on Landsdowne Street onto Jersey Street.
- Traffic management will be positioned at the road closure locations to safely manage traffic around the area.
- There may be parking restrictions in place along the road closure routes.
